ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS:

ENGINEERING & MAINTENANCE MATTERS:

10020 West Montgomery Avenue: No further update other than that the homeowner states they are still moving forward with subdividing their property.

5500 S. Simms Street: The owner of the proposed new bulk seafood individual sale business has put this project on hold and likely will not be moving forward.

Jefferson County Paving Project: Jeffco has notified the District that they are planning to repave a portion of the streets generally within Westridge, specifically the streets south of W. Alamo Place and east of S. Oak Street, except for the W. Powers Place and W. Dorado Avenue cul-de-sacs off S. Oak Street and S. Jellison Street/W. Berry Drive. Martin/Martin is coordinating with Jeffco and the District operator to get the required manhole riser rings for the project.

<u>2023 Capital Improvements</u>: A pre-construction meeting is scheduled for March 27. The contractor has tentatively scheduled this CIPP lining project to start the last two weeks of April.

FINANCIAL MATTERS:

<u>Check Register</u>: Nicki Simonson presented the District's check register for February 1, 2023 through February 28, 2023. Bill Geddes moved to ratify the check register and it was approved upon second by Bob Hart. The check register for March 1, 2023 through March 31 2023 was approved upon motion by Bill Geddes and second by Bob Hart.

<u>Financial Statements</u>: The District's February 28, 2023 financial statements are in draft form pending the audit.

<u>Investment Report:</u> Nothing to report other than interest rates continue to rise.
