The Southwest Suburban Denver Water and Sanitation District (SWSD) provides for the conveyance and treatment of wastewater from its service area through its contract with the Metro Wastewater Reclamation District (MWRD). All applicants for non-residential facilities must submit a set of plumbing plans to SWSD's Engineer for verification of oil/grease or oil/sand interceptor requirements, if any. All applicants shall submit this completed form to SWSD for approval along with payment of the MWRD and SWSD applicable fees, prior to a tap being made. All sewer taps must be inspected and approved by SWSD Engineer. Forty-eight (48) hours notice must be given when scheduling inspections. The District fee information provided on this application is subject to change and should be verified by the applicant prior to submitting for approval. This application is subject to SWSD's rules and regulations, including all present and future revisions thereto. Applicant hereby agrees that they have reviewed the District's rules and regulations and shall adhere to same.

SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT FEES

SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL EQUIVALENT (SFRE) A Single Family Residential Equivalent, as defined in Metro Wastewater Reclamation District's Rules and Regulations, Section 7.4.1, is equal to (1) Single Family Unit which means a building or structure used or designed to be used as only one residential unit; each residential unit in a duplex; and each residential unit having water service separately connect to the water main or a private water distribution system in a building or structure with three or more residential units.
